Introduction

Thank you for choosing the ISRA-PVF voting guide as your source of candidate information for the Illinois 2010 Primary Election. The selections below were arrived at by the ISRA-PVF board of directors based on a careful analysis of the candidates' voting records, public comments, and stated positions on issues important to law abiding Illinois gun owners. There are three classes of candidates. "Endorsed" candidates have established, consistent records of support for gun rights issues. "Preferred" candidates do not qualify for endorsement, but they are the candidates the ISRA-PVF would prefer to see win their respective elections. In cases where candidates are equally good, equally bad, or completely unknown, then the rating of "no preference" is given. For the sake of saving space, "no preference" races are not included in this voting guide. Please feel free to take this voting guide with you into the polling place on Election Day.

Illinois Governor - Republican



Senator Kirk Dillard - Senator Dillard was selected for endorsement from a large and very qualified field of Republican hopefuls. The decision was very difficult in light of the fact that the field included a very good friend of the law-abiding gun owner - Senator Bill Brady, along with two other candidates with solid positions on gun rights. But, in the end, the ISRA-PVF board of directors decided that Sen. Dillard had the best hope of defeating anti-gun extremist, Jim Ryan, in the Primary Election.

Illinois Lieutenant Governor - Republican



Mr. Jason Plummer - Candidate Jason Plummer was chosen as the preferred candidate in the Republican primary race for Illinois Lieutenant Governor. Based on discussions with Mr. Plummer, it became evident that he has a true understanding of the importance of the role of the right to keep and bear arms in Illinois' heritage, and its future.
